For your safety, we strongly recommend registering for Water Alerts at www.cherrycreekwater.com or at the office.

Try to keep the area around your water meter clear.

Easy access to and clear sight of the meter box means less time the meter reader is around your property and more time for us to accurately determine if there is a problem with the meter or the probability of a leak.

Payment Options

- ❖ **Online banking:**
 - Add Cherry Creek Waterworks as a payee.
 - For Quarterly Water Tolls use your account number **only** (ex.10101).
 - **For Parcel Tax, use your account number Plus a P on the end** (ex. 10101P).
- ❖ **Cheques** can be put into our mail slot at the office. Please do NOT put CASH in the mail slot.
- ❖ **Debit/Cheque/Cash** in office.
- ❖ **Pay at your bank.**

At the Cherry Creek Waterworks office, water bills are sent out quarterly. **Expect a water bill to be due at the end of March, June, September, and December.** Parcel tolls also are due at the end of September.
