Beaver Creek has raised their development cost charge bylaw. Wes Kovacs: Thank you for the update, we will need to review ours and ensure it is also in line with our surrounding communities. City watermain break, are there opportunities to share inventory during emergencies? Wes Kovacs: We have worked with our surrounding waterworks in the past and are always open to working together. Your tender was purchased with a stainless-steel water tank, as well as lined high volume hose could be used to distribute potable water during an emergency. Wes Kovacs: That is great information, we will investigate requirements to deliver potable water with this equipment.

Wendy Johnston: Why do building permits take so long?

- Mike Sparrow: It is a process that goes through many different departments. Unfortunately, it is what it is. If you need to subdivide the process is extended even longer. The ACRD is trying to speed this process up.
- Also working on streamlining the mailing and public notice process
 - Dana Forrester: There has been confusion with the ACRD signs being placed across the street from the waterworks office.
- ACRD and Mike Sparrow will be looking at more town hall meetings in Cherry Creek to involve the public more.
